I am at the point in my career where I cannot solely research the topics I explore, especially one as multifaceted as this where the primary research stems from eastern countries. It feels like my previous works have been leading up to this project as my reviews with my mentor proofed. Nevertheless I think of it more as a milestone to expand my role as a researcher, seeing the results of this pathway in my photographic practise while also moving into a personal perspective I have not dared to explore before.

Beyond the progression this work will mark in my personal career and portfolio I hope the project will open doors to new cooperations such as galleries, archives, editorials and mentors evolving through the contacts and impact I can achieve.
